The Christian County PACS office is reaching out with a heartfelt request to support our neighbors who are homebound.

Each day, PACS provides meals to more than 200 individuals across Christian County through our home delivery program. Many of those we serve depend heavily on this service. However, during inclement weather, holidays, or recent funding restrictions, meal delivery may be paused—leaving individuals without reliable access to food.

To help bridge these gaps, we are seeking shelf-stable food donations that can be provided to homebound individuals to save for times when meals cannot be delivered.

Every donation—large or small—helps us continue serving as many people as possible and ensures our most vulnerable neighbors have food security when it's needed most.


Crafters
