

Our family favorite was the 11:00 pm service because at midnight we sang Silent Night and held our lighted candles high to welcome baby Jesus.



Flourless Peanut Butter Cookies

2 eggs -1 cup peanut butter - 1 cup sugar Preheat over to 350. Beat the eggs. Stir in the peanut butter and sugar. Drop by small spoonfuls onto an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake for 10-12 minutes. Optional: Mix in 1 cup chocolate chips with eggs, peanut butter, and sugar. Cathy Leneave

Growing up in San Antonio, my family's traditional Christmas Eve dinner was our homemade tamales. Several days before Christmas, my family gathered on a Saturday morning in assembly-line fashion to make these special delectables. It was our own Tamalada, coordinated by my father.

My sisters and I would spread masa on prepared corn husks, that were then topped with a spiced pork mixture made from my father's own recipe. The husk was folded, and each tamale was steamed to perfection. Many dozen were given to neighbors and friends for Christmas. Well into adulthood this annual tradition continued, and we all looked forward to it not only because of the tasty tamales but because it was a time to visit and spend time together. **Susan Becker**
